

## Your Health Benefit Card

The card provided is for all eligible students of the University of PEI Student Union Health Plan.

The Student Union, as a member of **The Campus Trust**, has worked with our administrator to provide an extended health benefit plan that meets the needs of our members.

For purposes of sustainability and to alleviate wait times during card production, we have decided to use the cardless approach. In order to assist your pharmacist, we have provided a paper card for processing of your original claim.

## How to use the NexgenRx card:

- ✓ Just take the benefit card provided with you when you visit the pharmacy and present it when it's time to pay.
- ✓ If your pharmacist indicates that they are not enrolled in the network please ask them to call the toll-free enrollment phone number noted on the card.
- ✓ If the provider does not or cannot submit your claim electronically, arrange payment and obtain an original prescription receipt.

Claim forms are available in the Student Union Office, W. A. Murphy Student Center or online at [www.upeisu.com](http://www.upeisu.com), fill in all the requested information and attach all original receipts, keeping copies for your records. Mail the claim to the address on the claim form.

## Drug Coverage

The Plan covers charges for most eligible drugs at 80% up to the Benefit Maximum of \$2,000 per student year.

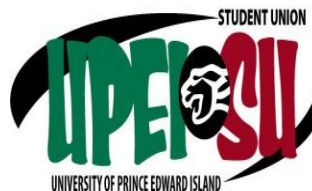
**NOTE: Please be advised that every September 1 pay direct access will be suspended until mid October to allow for the eligibility list to be determined and uploaded. You should purchase any prescription drugs required during this time and submit the claim to The Campus Trust at the address on the claim form for reimbursement.**

The Drug Plan covers a list of eligible drugs, professionally compiled to address the needs of students. This **Student Managed Drug Formulary** is designed to help reduce the cost of the Plan while maintaining comprehensive quality care and benefits.
